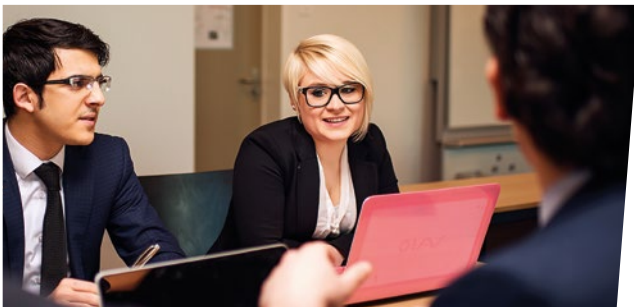

# PROGRAM OVERVIEW

## Intensive Hospitality English Language Program

Our Intensive Hospitality English Language Program (IHELP) focuses on intensive English learning while also teaching students important hospitality industry terminology and knowledge. It includes a hospitality discovery program with workshops, role play and hotel visits.

We offer this program to students who need help to fulfil the entry requirements of the Bachelor's program at Glion Institute of Higher Education. Our experienced teachers tailor the course to individual student needs to improve their English grammar, vocabulary, speaking, listening, pronunciation, reading and writing. Upon completion of the program, at the Glion campus in Switzerland, students will take an Academic English test, which is included in the fees.



## Full Immersion

In addition to being the home of hospitality management, Switzerland offers an exciting and stimulating learning environment and an unforgettable experience.

### **International environment**

Students are immersed in an English-speaking environment on our campus so they have to interact in English with fellow students and faculty in many different social and academic situations.

## How it Works

**6-week course:** designed for students who have an minimum overall IELTS score of 5.0.

**20-week course:** designed for students who have an minimum overall IELTS score of 4.5.

Students must achieve an IELTS score of 5.5 to enroll in an undergraduate program at Glion Institute of Higher Education in Switzerland or London, UK.

**Intakes:** two per year

**Duration:** 6 or 20 weeks depending on the student's IELTS level or equivalent English test

**Hours per week:** on average, 22 classroom hours plus 15-20 hours of independent learning

### Candidate requirements:

- **Entry level:** Requires IELTS 4.5 to 5.0
- **Minimum age:** 17 years or 17 years 3 months for the 6-week IHELP



## Learning Outcomes

At the completion of the program students will be able to perform the following:

- Write papers with the necessary skills to achieve accuracy
- Employ oral communication with confidence
- Understand written texts and recognize different approaches to writing
- Understand the general meaning and key information in spoken contexts
- Show an awareness of a variety of cultural perspectives
- Understand key concepts and their context within the world of hospitality

# PROGRAM CHOICES 2018

Students can undertake the IHELP in Switzerland and then continue their studies at Glion, or they can elect to transfer to London. If a student completes IHELP in Switzerland and achieves the English level required to study in the United Kingdom they can transfer in Semester 3.

## 2018 Bachelor's Degree English Entry Requirements

- Glion, Switzerland: IELTS 5.5 overall and minimum 5.0 in all subcomponents
- London, United Kingdom: minimum IELTS 5.5 in all subcomponents

# APPLICATION AND FEES 2018

## Admission Requirements

- Must be 17 years old or above or 17 and 3 months for the 6 week program.
- English level: IELTS 4.5 to 5.0 on application. Equivalent English certificates such as Cambridge and TOEFL are accepted on application and all English certificates must have been issued in the last 12 months prior to admission.
- Must hold a valid passport. Nationals of any country can apply and follow the required process for obtaining a visa.

## How to Apply

1. Complete the CH or UK application form and select the IHELP program required.
2. Provide a copy of your IELTS English language level certificate or equivalent.
3. Arrange payment of the program fees.

## 2018 Dates

We suggest the following start dates depending on the IELTS requirement needed to enroll into a Glion degree program.

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### **For students who have a minimum IELTS score of 5.0:**

We recommend the 6-week IHELP starting either in January or August, to begin semester one in February or September.

### **6-Week IHELP Arrival & End Dates**

- 6 January 2018 - 16 February 2018
  - 21 July 2018 - 31 August 2018
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### **For students who have a minimum IELTS score of 4.5:**

We recommend the 20-week IHELP starting either in February or September to begin semester one the following intake.

### **20-Week IHELP Arrival and End Dates**

- 21 February 2018 - 20 July 2018
- 5 September 2018 - 8 February 2019

### Fees Do Not Include:

- Pocket money, laundry costs, visa fees, airport transfers in home country and flights.
- If transferring to the United Kingdom, all students, regardless of nationality, are entitled to Accident and Emergency care free of charge. However, for all other health related matters health insurance is required. For further information please see the Fee Schedule.
- **Please note:** in the case of a cancellation, we will refund the total amount of the program if the cancellation is made 14 days or more prior to the start of the program in writing to the Admissions Department. 50% of the full amount will be refunded if cancellation occurs up to 14 days before the start of the program. No refund will apply if the student does not attend or start on the first day of the course without cancelling beforehand.
